<p>Rule 3-7 Direct Shipment of Wine by Wineries.</p> <p>(a) Any manufacturer of wine who desires to ship wines to residents of the County of Hawai'i shall obtain a Direct Wine Shipper Permit from the Department of Liquor Control, County of Hawai'i. The permit may be granted by the Director to any person holding:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. A general excise tax license from the State of Hawai'i Department of Taxation; and</li> <li>2. Either:             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A. A Class 1 license to manufacture wine under Section 281-31, Hawai'i Revised Statutes; or</li> <li>B. A license to manufacture wine issued by another state.</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <p>(b) The term of the permit shall be for one calendar year. The applicant for a permit shall submit:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. An application form;</li> <li>2. A copy of the State of Hawai'i Department of Taxation General Excise Tax License;</li> <li>3. A copy of the Class 1 license to manufacture wine under Section 281-31, Hawai'i Revised Statutes, or the license to manufacture wine issued by another state, and</li> <li>4. Payment of an annual permit fee of \$48.00 provided that the annual permit fee for a manufacturer of wine licensed under Section 281-31, Hawai'i Revised Statutes, shall be inclusive and part of its annual license fee. For purposes of this rule, permit fees shall be prorated.</li> </ol> <p>No permit shall be issued unless the applicant has met the foregoing requirements.</p> <p>(c) The holder of a direct wine shipper permit may sell and annually ship to any person twenty-one years of age or</p>	<p>older in this county no more than six nine-liter cases of wine per household for personal use only and not for resale and shall:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Ship wine directly to the person only in containers that are conspicuously labeled with the words containing or similar to:  "CONTAINS ALCOHOL: SIGNATURE OF PERSON AGE 21 YEARS OR OLDER REQUIRED FOR DELIVERY."</li> <li>2. Require that the carrier of the shipment obtain the signature of any person twenty-one years of age or older before delivering the shipment;</li> <li>3. Report, no later than January 31 of each year, to the liquor department the total amount of wine shipped to persons in this county during the preceding calendar year;</li> <li>4. Pay all applicable general excise and gallonage taxes. For gallonage tax purposes, all wine sold under a direct wine shipper permit shall be deemed to be wine sold in the state; and,</li> <li>5. Be subject to audit by the liquor department.</li> </ol> <p>(d) The holder of a license to manufacture wine issued by another state shall annually renew a direct wine shipper permit by providing the liquor department with a renewal application, a copy of the current license to manufacture wine and payment of the annual fee.</p> <p>(e) The sale and shipment of wine directly to a person in this state by a person that does not possess a valid direct wine shipper permit is prohibited. Knowingly violating this law is a misdemeanor.</p>
